

# ASTRO 40th MALAYSIAN NATIONAL BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

11 - 19 March 2016

Venue: Sunway Mega Lanes, Sunway Pyramid

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **Rules:** All WTBA universal playing rules and regulations shall apply.
2. **Eligibility:** This Tournament is open to all current and paid up members of Affiliates of the MTBC. Eligibility for youth bowlers – born in 1995 & after, and for Peter Yap's Memorial Cup born in 2002 & after)
3. **Entry Fees:** All entries must be submitted with the relevant fees. No refund will be allowed.
4. **Registration Fees:** RM60.00 per bowler for National Closed Championships (one time payment only).
5. **Averages:** Only official averages of MTBC will be used. New bowlers without established average with MTBC must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective state associations and acceptance of the average is at the discretion of the tournament director.

All bowlers in the National Team and National Youth will be classified in the Open division or Youth Open division respectively. They will ineligible to bowl in any graded event.

### **Classification of Averages:-**

Men Open:	Open to All Bowlers
Men Graded:	Open to Bowlers with average below 200.
Women Open:	Open to All Bowlers
Women Graded:	Open to Bowlers with average below 190.
Boys Open:	Open to All Bowlers
Boys Graded:	Open to Bowlers with average below 195.
Girls Open:	Open to All Bowlers
Girls Graded:	Open to Bowlers with average below 190.

6. **Squad Times:** If preferred squad times indicated on the entry forms are not available, the Tournament Directors or their Assistants reserve the right to reallocate squad times at their discretion. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to open additional squads.
7. **Substitutions:** Substitutions may be allowed provided it is reported to one of the Tournament Directors or their Assistants and duly approved by either at least 15 minutes before the time of play.
8. **Participation:** Bowlers must play in their respective grades or in a higher one. Bowlers from a higher grade will be ineligible to play in any of the lower grades. Bowlers must start in their own grade first before upgrading to a higher grade.

9. **Qualifying:**

**Men & Women Open & Graded Division:-**

Each Qualifying Squad consists of 6 games moving lanes after each game.  
Game Fees: RM130.00 (6 games).

**Boys & Girls Open & Graded Divisions:-**

Each Qualifying Squad consists of 6 games moving lanes after each game.  
Game Fees: RM 110.00 (6 Games)

10. **MASTERS FINALS:**

- a. The qualifying scores will be based on 6 games series.
- b. In the event of a tie for the last position in the qualifying rounds, the highest last game in the qualified MQ shall decide.
- c. All qualifiers must check with the Tournament Directors 24 hours before their finals roll-off, to confirm the fixtures and/or to check for any changes in the schedule.

11. **MILO YOUTH MASTERS (*Boys and Girls*)**  
 This event is open to bowlers who were born in 1995 and after. The top 17 Boys Open division, 18 Boys Graded Division, 11 Youth Girls Open division and 12 Youth Girls Graded division, based on a 6 games series (RM110.00 per attempt) will be listed on the Championships' Result Board from the start of the qualifying till the 2100hrs squad on 17 March 2016. The finalist, together with the All-Events Boys and All-Events Girls Gold Medal winners from the Inter-state championships, will bowl 8 games in the Finals on Friday, 18 March 2016 at 0800hrs. Check-in at 0730hrs. Finals Game Fees at RM160.00.
12. **PETER YAP'S MEMORIAL CUP (*Boys and Girls - Under 14*)**  
 This event is open to bowlers who were born in 2002 and after. The first 96 fully-paid entries (RM60.00) will be accepted to participate in the Peter Yap's Memorial. Bowlers will bowl 4 games in the Finals on Saturday, 19 March 2016 at 1200hrs. Check-in at 1130hrs.
13. **MEN'S GRADED MASTERS**  
 This event is open to all Men bowlers with an average below 200, except those in the National Elite, National Back-up Elite and National Youth. The top 24 qualifiers will bowl **8 games** in the Finals on Friday, 18 March 2016 at 2030hrs. Check-in at 2000hrs. Game Fees: RM220.00
14. **WOMEN'S GRADED MASTERS**  
 This event is open to all Women bowlers with an average below 190, except those in the National Elite, National Back-up Elite and National Youth. The top 12 qualifiers will bowl **8 games** in the Finals on Friday, 18 March 2016 at 2030hrs. Check-in at 2000hrs. Game Fees: RM220.00.
15. **WOMEN'S OPEN MASTERS**  
 This event is open to all women bowlers.

**Round 1: Preliminary**

Top 10 qualifiers & All-Events Gold winner from the Interstate Championship, together with the Defending champion will play **10 games** on Saturday, 19 March 2016 at 0830hrs, check-in at 0800hrs. Top 3 bowlers based on highest total pinfalls shall proceed to the Step-Ladder Finals.

### **Step-Ladder Finals**

The 1<sup>st</sup> match of the Step-Ladder Finals shall be played between the 3<sup>rd</sup> placed and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed bowler over 1 game. The 2<sup>nd</sup> match shall be between the winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> match against the 1<sup>st</sup> placed bowler on a 1 + 1 match. Should the 1<sup>st</sup> placed bowler wins the 1<sup>st</sup> game, the bowler shall be declared the champion. Should the winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> match wins the first game, there shall be another game, with the winner declared the champion.

Reserves will be called 15 minutes before the start of the Master Final, according to the positions in the Qualifying List.

Game Fees - RM270.00

## 16. **MEN'S OPEN MASTERS**

This event is open to all men bowlers.

### **Round 1: Preliminary**

Top 14 qualifiers & All-Events Gold winner from the Interstate Championship, together with the Defending champion will play **10 games** on Saturday, 19 March 2016 at 0830hrs, check-in at 0800hrs. Top 3 bowlers based on highest total pinfalls shall proceed to the Step-Ladder Finals.

### **Step-Ladder Finals**

The 1<sup>st</sup> match of the Step-Ladder Finals shall be played between the 3<sup>rd</sup> placed and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed bowler over 1 game. The 2<sup>nd</sup> match shall be between the winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> match against the 1<sup>st</sup> placed bowler on a 1 + 1 match. Should the 1<sup>st</sup> placed bowler wins the 1<sup>st</sup> game, the bowler shall be declared the champion. Should the winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> match wins the first game, there will be another game with the winner declared the champion.

Reserves will be called 15 minutes before the start of the Master Final, according to the positions in the Qualifying List.

Game Fees - RM 270.00

## 17. **REPORTING TIME**

All Masters Finalists must check in **personally** minimum 30 minutes before their respective roll-off times. Reserves will be called 15 minutes before roll-off. Centre Clock is the official time piece.

18. **Verification of Scores:** It is the responsibility of each bowler and/or the team captain to verify the correctness of each game bowled by signing the official master score sheet. Once signed, the scores shall stand, unless otherwise decided by the Tournament Committee.

In the event of any interruptions caused by power failure, the following procedure shall be followed:

- a) Any part of a game that cannot be recalled will be rebowled from the first frame.
- b) If more than one game cannot be recalled, the series shall be declared null and void and a fresh series be rescheduled.
- c) If only one frame is missing, the bowler shall continue from the last frame bowled.

19. **Registration of Bowling Balls Illegality and Disqualification:**

**No registration will be carried out during the Championship.** All participants must ensure their bowling balls used have been checked as legal for weight and other specifications. The onus is on the bowler to ensure that all bowling balls he/she uses fall within specification as required by WTBA. The Tournament Directors reserves the right to check at random, bowling balls used by any bowler in the Championships.

If at any time a bowler is found to have used an illegal ball, he/she shall be disqualified from the entire Tournament and stripped of all his/her medals or positions standing.

20. **Ties Breaking Procedure:**

- i) When a tie occurs for the last placed in the masters qualifying, the highest last game in the qualified MQ shall decide. In the Step-Ladder Finals format, one ball roll off shall decide until the tie is broken.
- ii) If a tie occurs in the 3rd position after the last game roll off of the Open Masters, there will be a 1 ball roll-off to determine the winner.

21. **Cheating:** Any bowler found guilty of cheating at scores, averages eligibility or on any other counts will be immediately disqualified from the entire Tournament and reported to the Disciplinary Committee of the MTBC for further action. He/she will also be stripped of his/her winnings and positions standing and be asked to return to one of the Tournament Directors any awards that may have already been given to him/her. When in doubts, bowlers are reminded to consult with the Tournament Directors on any issue.

22. **Bowlers Attire:**

- a) Bowlers are requested to be dressed for their events with a sense of decorum.
- b) Bowlers are not permitted to wear the following:-
  - i) Men Bowlers – Short, Jeans, Singlet, and Cap.
  - ii) Women Bowlers – Jeans & Singlet.

23. **Slow Bowling:** Bowlers who are in readiness to step on the approach to deliver a ball, shall have the following rights and obligations.

- a) They may claim right of way over anyone moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately on their left.
- b) They may claim right of way over anyone moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately on their right.
- c) Players shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn should not delay to go to the approach, if a lane immediately adjacent to them on the left and right side is clear.

- d) Penalty shall be imposed to bowler/s who is four (4) frames (For Singles, Doubles and Masters Finals), and two (2) frames (for Team Event) slower from the leader not counting the end pair of lanes. The penalty will be to forfeit the score in the next frame.

24. **Protests:**

- a) Scores: Must be submitted in writing to one of the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 12 hours of the event, and in the case of an elimination round, before the next round. In the case of the last match of the Step-ladder Grand Finals of the Masters event, such protests, if any should be made to the same Officials before prize presentation. No protests made after Prize Presentation will be entertained.
- b) Foul: Must be brought to the attention of the lane marshal before the delivery of the next ball. No complaints made after the 2nd ball has been bowled shall be entertained.
- c) Eligibility: Must be submitted in writing to either the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 24 hours of the first infringement or before the next round or prize presentation whichever is earlier.

25. **Altering of Bowling Ball Surface**

Altering the surface of bowling balls is allowed in a designated area during the official practice session, during the practice session immediately preceding a competition round, and between games. A player may not alter the surface of the bowling ball during a game.

26. **Special Notes:**

- a) Bowlers are requested to refrain from swearing on the lanes.
- b) Smoking is prohibited for all bowlers and coaches during the block of games.
- c) Bowlers shall restrict themselves to their specific lanes and exercise consideration for all participants.
- d) Bowlers wearing soft rubber soles on their non-sliding foot may be barred from further bowling subject, to the scrutiny of the Tournament Directors.
- e) The Tournament Directors reserve the right to accept or reject any entry they deem fit.
- f) Any matters arising and not covered in these Tournament Rules will be decided by the Tournament Chairman or the Tournament Directors, whose decision shall be final subject only to appeal to the MTBC Council. Such appeal should be made in writing and within 48 hours of the decision by any of the above.
